## SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

### 1. Rights of Public Entity

The Eenhana Town Council reserves the right:

- (a) To split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) To accept or reject any quotation.
- (c) To cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.
- (d) Council reserves the right to conduct a physical inspection of the bidder's equipment and facilities before award of the quotation.
- (e) Do arithmetic corrections and verifications.

### 2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) The Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for *Bid Securing Declaration*;
- (b) The List of Goods and Price Schedule Section III.
- (c) The Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V.
- (d) Attach letters of reference for previous work done, and
- (d) Any other attachment deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Sealed Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

### 3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be [60] days from the date of submission deadline.

### 4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, bidders should:

- (a) Submit a valid Company Registration Certificate.
- (b) Submit a valid original or certified copy of a Good Standing Tax Certificate.
- (c) Submit a valid original or certified copy of a Good Standing Social Security Certificate.

- (d) Submit a valid certified copy of an Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from the Employment Equity Commissioner that the bidder is not a relevant employer, or an exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998 (Optional).
- (e) Submit a duly signed Bid Securing Declaration.
- (f) Submit a valid Fitness Certificate.
- (g) Attach at least one (1) reference letter from corporate entities for similar works previously completed, specifically relating to the renting/hiring of tent services for events accommodating approximately 300–350 people.
- (h) Provide pictures as evidence of similar works undertaken for corporate events, and
- (i) Submit a certified copy of the Identification Document (ID) of the owner(s) of the company.
- (j) Submission of company profile detailing previous experience in event management or tent hiring services.
- (k) Confirmation that the bidder can provide services within the required location and timeframe.

#### **4.1 Evaluation Criteria**

- Documents must be fully completed in black ink.
- The use of correction fluid (corrector) is not permitted.
- All pages must be initialed and signed, where applicable, by the person duly authorized to sign the bid.
- Any alterations or corrections made in the document must be initialed by the authorized signatory.
- The bidder's principal business activity must be related to the services required under this quotation exercise.
- Capacity to accommodate the required number of guests (300–350 people).
- Previous performance based on reference letters submitted.
- Presentation and professionalism of equipment based on pictures/catalogues provided.
- Understanding of the scope of work and event requirements.

**Bid Securing Declaration**

Bidders are required to submit a Bid Securing Declaration for this procurement process.

**5. Delivery**

**Deviation in delivery period shall not be accepted.**

The following tests and inspections will be conducted upon delivery of the goods/services:

- (a) Verification of compliance with the specified quality and size requirements.
- (b) Verification of compliance with the terms and conditions of this quotation/tender document.
- (c) Inspection of the condition and functionality of the supplied goods/equipment.
- (d) Verification that all items delivered correspond with the approved quotation and specifications, and
- (e) Confirmation that delivery/setup has been completed within the agreed timeframe and at the designated location.

**6. Sealing and Marking of Quotations**

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.

**7. Submission of Quotations**

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Bid Box located at Eenhana Town Council, *108 Church Street* not later than **15 June 2026 @ 12H00**. Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach Eenhana Town Council, *108 Church Street* by the same date and time at latest. Late quotations will be rejected.

**Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.**

**8. Opening of Quotations**

Quotations will be opened internally by the Public Entity immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, the presence or absence of a Bid Securing Declaration, will be posted on the website of the Public Entity and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

## 9. Evaluation of Quotations

The Public Entity shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of price or ownership cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

## 10. Technical Compliance

Bidders shall submit along with their quotation's documents, catalogues and any other literature to substantiate compliance with the required specifications and to qualify deviations if any with respect to Public Entity's requirements.

The Specifications, Performance Requirements and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the goods/items to be supplied. The specifications have to be met but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

## 11. Prices and Currency of Payment

Prices will be submitted in Namibia dollars only. However, Eenhana Town Council may allow for prices to be adjustable to change in rates of exchange of currency, price variation etc. depending on the behaviour of the market in respect of the specific goods items being procured.

Prices shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars.
